The Community Healthcare Clinic of Decatur County (CHC) is a non-profit organization serving residents of Decatur County that are either uninsured or under-insured by providing both medical and dental services at a very low cost. We are currently funded by the Decatur County United Fund and Decatur County Council with river boat funds, with support from the Decatur County Community Foundation, several churches, organizations, and private donors. We strive to ensure that if there is a resident in Decatur County, regardless of age or financial ability to pay, in need of medical or dental attention that they do not go without. The CHC currently supports over 100 families in Decatur County and we are always looking for more!

In the last year, the CHC has been working hard to improve services that are offered. We are currently fundraising to purchase new dental equipment. This will allow a complete remodel or our current dental area. In 2023, First Financial Bank acted as the seed to our food bank that is open to our patients on clinic days. We often partner with the Decatur County Board of Health to provide preventative care such as influenza vaccines. The Decatur County Purdue Extension Office has provided education on diabetes management to our patients. We work with many community partners to continue to provide and expand services to our patients.

Last year we hosted our 1st Annual Christmas Coloring Contest and we are back for year two! We received countiess entries last year that were so festive and fabulous! We hope that your child will consider participating again this year! Entries will be accepted from November 17th through December 2th. You can either turn in submissions to your school, drop them off at the CHC (in the Rural King Plaza), or email submissions to <u>CHC@etzone.com</u>. Gift cards will be awarded to our winners! We also invite you to attend your Christmas Open House on Stunday, December 8th from 2-4pm. We will host Santa, have snacks, a craft and the clinic will be open to tour. ADDITIONALLY, the top 10 submissions of our coloring contest will be on display to vote for the People's Choice Award. Finalist will be announced and notified by Thursday, December 5th. The CHC offers one medical clinic per week at a cost of \$10 per visit. We strive to offer a dental clinic once a month with a cost of \$20 associated. In addition to providing a medical or dental visit, we also work with patients to find additional resources that will benefit their family. 
- 1st practice for team placements will take place December 10th from 3:15pm -5:00pm at North Decatur Elementary gym.
