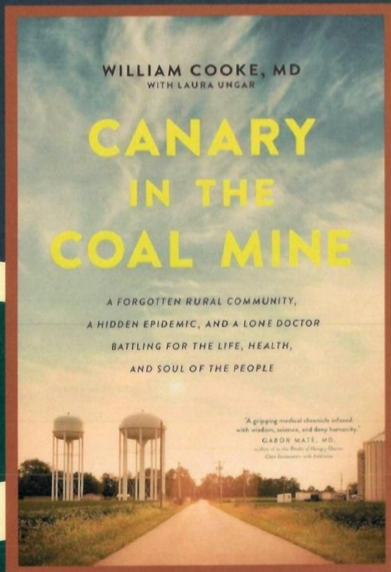
We will discuss the book *Canary in the Coal Mine: Reinventing in the Health and Wellness of America* by Dr. William Cooke, physician and author.

Dr. William Cooke was the sole doctor in Austin, Indiana when he found himself at the crossroads of two unprecedented health-care disasters: an opioid epidemic and the worst drug-fueled HIV outbreak ever seen in a rural American community. It made national and international news. He writes about his experience in his memoir. His story is compelling and relatable to communities throughout Indiana.

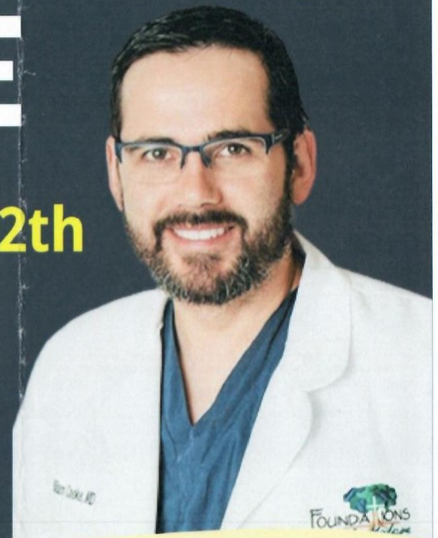
